**Modification of Certified Bargaining Unit**

Pursuant to RSA 273-A and PELRB Decision No. 2023-065 granting the Association's petition for modification, the existing certification, set forth in PELRB Certification of Representative and Order to Negotiate, Case No. T-0391 (October 12, 1989), is amended; and it is hereby ordered that the composition of the modified bargaining unit, represented by the Farmington Teachers Association, NEA-New Hampshire for purposes of collective negotiations and settlement of grievances, is as follows:

**Unit:** Teachers, media specialists, nurses, and school guidance counselors.

**Excluded:** Principals and Superintendents.

The Farmington School Board shall negotiate with the Farmington Teachers Association, NEA-New Hampshire as exclusive representative on the terms and conditions of employment for the members of the bargaining unit and shall recognize the right of the Farmington Teachers Association, NEA-New Hampshire to represent employees in the settlement of grievances.
