Order

On May 22, 2023, the AFSCME Council 93 (Union) filed an election petition for certification seeking to represent certain employees of the Town of Barrington. The Town objected to the petition. On June 5, 2023, the parties participated in a status conference to review the employee list filed by the Town and the Union's proposed bargaining unit composition. See PELRB Decision No. 2023-119. On June 16, 2023, pursuant to PELRB Decision No. 2023-119, the Union filed a motion to amend the petition and the amended petition for certification. The amended petition was supported by a requisite number of confidential authorization cards as reflected in the June 16, 2023 PELRB Report re: Inspection of Confidential Authorization Cards. The Town agrees with the unit composition proposed in the amended petition. No other objections, exceptions, or petitions to intervene have been filed in this case.

The Union's motion to amend its petition is granted. The parties agree to the following proposed composition of the bargaining unit:


Unit: Full time Truck Driver/Laborer/Equipment Operator, full time Transfer Station Lead Attendant, and part time Transfer Station Attendant.

Excluded: Road Agent and Administrative Assistant.

The proposed bargaining unit is approved. The PELRB will conduct a secret ballot election pursuant to RSA 273-A:10 to determine the exclusive representative of the approved unit, if any. "AFSCME Council 93" and "No Representative" will be included on a ballot. An Order for Election shall be issued, and a pre-election conference shall be conducted pursuant to Admin. R. Pub 303.02.
