Order

On September 18, 2023, the Teamsters Local Union 633 filed an election petition for certification seeking to represent certain employees of the Grafton County Sheriff's Office. The petition for certification was supported by a requisite number of confidential authorization cards as reflected in the October 5, 2023 PELRB Report re: Inspection of Confidential Authorization Cards. The County objected to the petition and a hearing was scheduled for October 26, 2023.

On October 23, 2023, the parties filed a stipulation proposing the following agreed upon bargaining unit:

Unit:

Civil Assistant, Criminal Assistant, Deputy Sheriff, Detective, Detective Sergeant, Dispatcher, Dispatch Supervisor, Lieutenant, and

Sergeant.

Excluded:

Sheriff, Director of Communications, Deputy Director of

Communications, and Captain.

The parties' agreement resolves the dispute in this case. The bargaining unit proposed by the parties is approved. Accordingly, the October 26, 2023 hearing is cancelled. The PELRB will conduct a secret ballot election pursuant to RSA 273-A:10 to determine the exclusive representative of the approved unit, if any. "Teamsters Local Union 633" and "No

Representative" will appear as choices on the ballot. An Order for Election shall issue and a pre-election conference shall be conducted pursuant to Pub 303.02.
