<u>Professional Firefighters of Hanover, Local 3288 v. Town of Hanover</u> and <u>Town of Hanover</u> v. <u>Professional Firefighters of Hanover, Local 3288</u>, Decision No. 2004-106 (Case No. F-0137-7 and Case No. F-0137-8)

Union claimed that town committed unfair labor practice by failing to comply with arbitrator's award ordering reinstatement of firefighter. Town claimed that union committed ULP by demanding award to be implemented and thereby breaching parties' contract. PELRB dismissed town's complaint finding that union did not breach of contract. PELRB ordered town to reinstate firefighter finding that town committed unfair labor practice by refusing to implement reinstatement portion of award.
