Complainant filed unfair labor practice complaints against city and union claiming that city prevented him from obtaining representative of his choice for investigative interview and that union failed to fairly represent him. PELRB sustained charges against city for violations of Weingarten rights and partially sustained charges against union finding that it violated RSA 273-A when it declined to represent complainant during internal affairs interview.
