

International Brotherhood of Police Officers, Local 320 v. Town of Merrimack, Decision No. 2004-182 (Case No. P-0723-8).

Union claimed that town committed unfair labor practice by rejecting tentative contract settlement reached between parties. PELRB denied union's complaint finding that town did not breach its obligation to bargain in good faith because town was acting within its valid and mutually agreed upon reservation of rights when it rejected tentative agreement.
