<u>Jaffrey Rindge Support Staff Association, NEA-New Hampshire v. Jaffrey Rindge</u> Cooperative School District, Decision No. 2004-183 (Case No. T-0419).

District objected to union's petition for certification claiming that instructional associates should not be included in proposed unit because union also represented teachers who supervised instructional associates. PELRB granted petition finding that supervision by teachers did not rise to level of significant exercise of discretion to preclude representation of teachers and instructional associates by same union.
