<u>Jessica Miehle v. Teamsters Local 633 of New Hampshire</u>, Decision No. 2004-185 (Case No. G-0003-2).

Complainant claimed that union committed unfair labor practice by attempting to cause town to discriminate against her due to her non-membership in union and by refusing to negotiate for her position with town in good faith. PELRB denied complaint finding that union did not attempt to cause town to discriminate against complainant and that union did not fail to negotiate on her behalf.
