AFSCME Local 3657 Merrimack Police and Fire Officers v. Town of Merrimack, Decision No. 2004-190 (Case No. G-0002-1).

Union claimed that town committed unfair labor practice by rejecting tentative contract settlement reached between parties. PELRB denied union's complaint finding that town's actions did not violate RSA 273-A:5, I because town's board of selectmen acted within its valid reservation of rights when it voted to reject tentative agreement.
