<u>Teamsters Local 633, Newmarket Police Association v. Town of Newmarket</u>, Decision No. 2004-197 (Case No. P-0776-1).

Town objected to union's petition for certification claiming that dispatcher positions did not share sufficient community of interest with remaining position in proposed unit. PELRB granted union's petition finding that dispatchers share sufficient community of interest with other positions to warrant their inclusion.
