<u>AFSCME Local 1801/Derry Public Works v. Town of Derry</u>, Decision No. 2005-022 (Case No. A-0413-35).

Union claimed that town committed unfair labor practice by failing to uniformly apply results of arbitration award relative to loss of disability retirement benefits by one employee. PELRB dismissed union's complaint finding that it lacked jurisdiction to consider whether award had precedential effect as arbitrator's final and binding award made no clear statement of precedential effect.
