Hampton Police Association v. Town of Hampton, Decision No. 2005-113 (Case No. P-0719-19).

Union claimed that town committed unfair labor practice by posting memorandum to all police officers thereby attempting to address and coerce members of certified unit by direct communication. PELRB ordered town to cease and desist from directly dealing with union members finding that town's direct communication with union members constituted commission of unfair labor practice.
