<u>Town of Hampton v. Hampton Firefighters, Local 2664, IAFF, AFL-CIO, CLC</u> and <u>Town of Hampton v. Hampton Firefighters, Local 2664, IAFF, AFL-CIO, CLC</u>, Decision No. 2005-124 (Case No. F-0118-13 and Case No. F-0118-14).

Town claimed that union committed unfair labor practices by filing grievances relating to shift configuration and fire station coverage. PELRB granted union's motions to dismiss town's complaints and directed parties to proceed to arbitration finding that it lacked jurisdiction to consider matters based upon arbitration provisions of parties' collective bargaining agreement.
