<u>Lisbon Association of Paraprofessionals, NEA-New Hampshire v. Lisbon Regional School District</u>, Decision No. 2006-001 (Case No. E-0007-1).

Union claimed that district committed unfair labor practice by refusing to pay certain health insurance benefits in violation of collective bargaining agreement. PELRB dismissed union's charges and ordered parties to return to negotiations finding that subject contract provisions were ambiguous and that there was never mutual understanding between parties as to scope of health insurance coverage.
