<u>Town of Milford and AFSCME Local 3657, Milford Police Employees</u>, Decision No. 2006-046 (Case No. A-0480-21).

Town sought declaratory ruling as to composition of bargaining unit claiming that, while certification excluded sergeants from unit, recognition clause included them and that sergeant were supervisory employees. PELRB found that status quo doctrine applied to parties' recognition clause and that town was obligated to recognize sergeants under agreement despite conflict it created with certification.
