Incumbent union objected to union's petition to certify and modify units claiming that supervisory unit contained non-supervisory employees; that employees were covered by existing certification; and that employer did not agree to composition of unit. PELRB granted union's petitions finding that community of interest existed within proposed units; that decertification of incumbent union was not necessary; and that union and employer agreed on composition of unit.
