

Classified Employee Petitioners of the New Hampshire Office of Information Technology v. SEA/SEIU Local 1984, Decision No. 2006-181 (Case No. S-0411-3).

Incumbent union objected to petitioners' petition for decertification claiming, inter alia, that they lacked standing and failed to present 30% showing of interest, and that petition was untimely. PELRB ordered matter to proceed to election, even though election could occur outside of election window, finding that petitioners satisfied 30% showing of interest and that petition was timely.
