

Classified Employee Petitioners of the New Hampshire Department of Labor v. SEA/SEIU Local 1984, Decision No. 2006-186 (Case No. S-0310-1)

Union objected to employees' petition for decertification claiming, inter alia, that employees failed to present requisite 30% showing of interest. PELRB dismissed decertification petition finding that employees did not satisfy 30% requirement because probationary employees and unfilled positions could not be counted nor were they eligible to sign cards or vote at election.
