

Non-Supervisory Classified Employees of NH Employment Security and State Employees' Association of New Hampshire, SEIU Local 1984; Classified Supervisory Employees of NH Employment Security and State Employees' Association of New Hampshire, SEIU Local 1984; and Classified Employees of NH Employment Security and State Employees' Association of New Hampshire, SEIU Local 1984, Decision No. 2006-193 (Case No. S-0306-4, Case No. S-0306-5 & Case No. S-0306-6).

PELRB, over incumbent union's numerous objections, granted employees' petitions for decertification and ordered matter to proceed to election, even though election itself would take place after deadline, finding that employees satisfied requirements of RSA 273-A and PELRB rules, including requisite showing of 30% interest.
