I.U.O.E. Local 98 v. Town of Pembroke, Decision No. 2006-205 (Case No. G-0039).

Town objected to union's petition for certification claiming that position of secretary in proposed unit was confidential position and that position of foreman was supervisory position. PELRB granted union's petition finding that secretary was not confidential position and that evidence did not show that foreman was supervisory position involving significant exercise of discretion.
