<u>Farmington Education Support Professionals United, NEA-NH and Farmington School District, Decision No. 2020-260 (Case No. E-0047-7).</u>

<u>Background</u>: The Union filed a modification petition pursuant to N.H. Admin. Rule Pub 302.05 seeking to add the position of administrative assistant to the existing bargaining unit. The District objected to the petition claiming, among other things, that the petition violated Admin. Rule Pub 302.05 in that there had been no change in circumstances and the unit was not incorrect to the degree warranting modification.

<u>Decision</u>: The Union's modification petition was dismissed on the ground that the evidence was insufficient to prove that there had been a sufficient change in circumstances since the bargaining unit was formed in 1989 to warrant a modification of the bargaining unit in this case.
