CERTIFICATION OF REPRESENTATIVE AND ORDER TO NEGOTIATE

Pursuant to the authority vested in the Board by the Public Employee Labor Relations Act (RSA 273-A), the parties having reached an agreement on the composition of the unit, and a representation election having been conducted pursuant to Decision No. 2009-216 and in accordance with RSA 273-A:10 and Pub 303, IT IS HEREBY CERTIFIED that NEPBA Local 260, IUPA, AFL-CIO, has been designated and selected by a majority of the employees of the above named public employer, in the unit described below, as their representative for purposes of collective negotiations and settlement of grievances.

UNIT: All Liquor Investigators I and II and Sergeants employed by the State of New Hampshire Liquor Commission, Bureau of Enforcement and Licensing.

Further, IT IS ORDERED that the above named public employer shall negotiate collectively with the exclusive representative named herein on terms and conditions of employment for the members of the bargaining unit, as herein described, and shall recognize the right of such exclusive representative to represent employees in the settlement of grievances.
