ORDER ON REMAND


The Board, meeting at its offices in Concord, New Hampshire, on June 9, 1998, took the following actions:

- 1. It convened to hear the arguments of the parties as the result of the granting of a motion for rehearing in this matter in Decision No. 1997-105 (October 30, 1997).
2. The Association appeared and was represented by UniServ Director Mary Gaul. The District was represented by Edward Kaplan, Esquire. They stipulated that guidance counselor Edward Singer was no longer employed by the District and that he had been replaced by persons occupying more than a one-person full-time position. (Decision No. 1997-078, August 29, 1997.) No other stipulations were offered.
3. It heard oral arguments offered by the Association and the District and accepted the Association's Memorandum in Support of the Motion for Rehearing.

4. It AFFIRMED its findings and order in Decision No. 1997-078 (August 29, 1997) and directed no new or further remedies.
