To: New Hampshire Public Employers

Re: N.H. RSA 273-A:16, V (effective June 4, 2013)

Public employers involved in RSA 273-A collective bargaining now have a specific reporting obligation relating to votes on collective bargaining agreements and fact finder reports pursuant to the following amendment to N.H. RSA 273-A:16, V:

*V. Within 14 days after a legislative body votes on a collective bargaining agreement or a fact finding report, the result of such vote shall be reported by the public employer to the board, which shall maintain a record of such information and provide an annual summary report to the speaker of the house of representatives and the senate president.*

**Who must respond:** Any public employer whose legislative body (i.e. City Council, Board of Aldermen, Town Meeting, State Legislature, County Delegation) voted on a collective bargaining agreement or a fact finder's report since June 4, 2013.

**How to report:** Complete and return "Public Employer Report Form 273-A:16, V" to [pelrb@nh.gov](mailto:pelrb@nh.gov). The form is available on the PELRB website at [www.nh.gov/pelrb](http://www.nh.gov/pelrb) or may be obtained by sending an email to [pelrb@nh.gov](mailto:pelrb@nh.gov) requesting the form.

**When to report:** 14 days after the legislative vote. Note: report all votes since the June 4, 2013 effective date of N.H. RSA 273-A:16, V even if more than 14 days has passed.

This is an ongoing reporting requirement. Contact our office by email or at 271-2587 with questions as necessary.
