**FINAL ORDER**

On March 17, 2016, the New Hampshire Board of Podiatry (“the Board”) suspended Dr. Edward P. Newcott’s license on an emergency basis, pursuant to RSA 315:10-b and RSA 541-A:30, III. The Board issued an “Order of Emergency License Suspension and Notice of Hearing” and set the hearing for March 23, 2016.

On March 21, 2016, the Board received a letter from Dr. Newcott stating that he is retiring from the practice of podiatry, effective immediately. Dr. Newcott further stated that he relinquishes his New Hampshire license to practice podiatry and will not seek any further renewals of said license.

That same day, the Board received a motion from Hearing Counsel entitled “Hearing Counsel’s Petition to Accept Respondent’s Retirement Letter and Cancel Hearing.” In this motion, Hearing Counsel stated her belief that Dr. Newcott’s “retirement and his surrender of his license to practice podiatry is the most appropriate resolution of the case and adequately protects the public.” Pet. To Accept Retirement Letter at ¶ 4. As such, Hearing Counsel requested the Board to accept Dr. Newcott’s retirement letter and cancel the hearing scheduled for March 23, 2016.

The Board construes Dr. Newcott’s letter, assented-to in Hearing Counsel’s motion, as a voluntary surrender of his license to practice podiatry. The Board hereby GRANTS Dr.

Newcott's voluntary surrender. As Dr. Newcott is no longer a licensed podiatrist and has agreed not to seek renewal, the Board GRANTS Hearing Counsel's request to cancel the hearing scheduled for March 23, 2016.
