MODIFICATION OF FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

On December 10, 2014 the New Hampshire Board of Registration in Podiatry (“Board”) approved a modification to the Final Decision and Order dated November 19, 2014. As of December 10, 2014, the Board modifies the “Disciplinary Action” section of the Final Decision and Order as follows.


Under the “Disciplinary Action” section of the Final Decision and Order, the sentence stating, “That the Respondent is fined \$8,000 to be paid within 90 (ninety) days of the effective date of this Order; and” is deleted and replaced with the following language:

“That the Respondent is fined \$8,000, with \$2,000 to be paid quarterly. The first \$2,000 payment must be paid by January 31, 2015. Each remaining payment must be paid by the following dates: April 30, 2015, July 31, 2015, and October 31, 2015. Payment must be in the form of a bank or certified check. If a payment is missed, Respondent’s license will be suspended. Once the first payment, due January 31, 2015, is made and the 6 CEU’s in infection control are completed Respondent’s suspension will be lifted; and...”

The remainder of the disciplinary terms in the “Disciplinary Action” section of the Final Decision and Order remain in full force and effect.
