## **NEW IFTA ACCOUNT REQUIREMENTS**

Any person based in a member jurisdiction operating an IFTA qualified motor vehicle(s) in two or more member jurisdictions is required to license under the IFTA Agreement.

An IFTA qualified motor vehicle is a motor vehicle used, designed, or maintained for the transportation of persons or property and:

- Having two axles and a gross vehicle weight or registered gross vehicle weight exceeding 26,000 pounds or 11,797 kilograms; or
- Having three or more axles regardless of weight; or
- Is used in combination, when the weight of such combination exceeds 26,000 pounds or 11,797 kilograms gross vehicle or registered gross vehicle weight.

Note: IFTA Qualified Motor Vehicle does not include recreational vehicles used exclusively for recreational purposes.

If your company has IFTA qualified vehicles, please contact the Road Toll Bureau at the number above to obtain an IFTA licensing packet.

## IFTA Licensing Requirements:

- Active or Authorized DOT# for interstate operations (<u>www.fmcsa.dot.gov</u>).
- Copy of current IRP registration(s).
- Secretary of State registration that is Active or in Good Standing (<u>https://quickstart.sos.nh.gov</u>)
- Unified Carrier Registration (UCR) You must have a current and active UCR registration. Anyone can pay for their UCR fees online (<u>www.ucr.gov</u>). If your company is NH based, you can pay your UCR fees at our office.
- IFTA Application (<u>www.nh.gov/safety/divisions/administration/roadtoll/forms.html</u>)
- W-9
- \$10.00 per IFTA qualified vehicle to obtain a set of IFTA decals. 2 decals are included in each set, one for each side of the vehicle.
