To Whom It May Concern:

During the 2016 Legislative Session SB 494 passed and was signed by the Governor on June 3, 2016. The effective date of this legislation is January 1, 2017. Below is the final version of SB 494. The bracketed language with the single line strikethrough indicates the language that was removed and the language in bold is the new amended language.

CHAPTER 189
SB 494-FN-A - FINAL VERSION

STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

In the Year of Our Lord Two Thousand Sixteen

AN ACT limiting an exemption from the road toll.

1. Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

189:1 Exemption From Road Toll. Amend RSA 260:32, I to read as follows:


I. Sales to the United States~~[, its agencies or instrumentalities; and diplomatic or consular personnel certified by the United States Department of State]~~ **government for use of the armed forces only.**

189:2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect January 1, 2017.

The amendment limits the Road Toll exemption to the United States government armed forces only. The definition for "Armed forces" is defined by Revised Statute Annotated 21:50 paragraph II which means the United States Army, Army Reserve, Navy, Naval Reserve, Marine Corps, Marine Corps Reserve, Air Force, Air Force Reserve, Coast Guard, Coast Guard Reserve, Army National Guard, and the Air National Guard.

The exemption no longer extends to the United States civilian agencies (i.e. General Services Administration; Department of Veterans Affairs) or instrumentalities (i.e. United States Postal Service); and diplomatic or consular personnel certified by the United States Department of State. These entities are no longer eligible to purchase fuel in bulk or retail without paying the road toll after December 31, 2016.
