Subject: RATE INCREASE ON FUEL OIL DISCHARGE FEE (FOD)

Dear Licensee:

The Road Toll Bureau anticipates that effective July 1, 2013 the Fuel Oil Discharge fee (FOD) will increase to \$0.0125 per gallon. Per HB 185, the anticipated change to RSA 146-E:3 paragraph II, effective July 1, 2013 reads as follows: "A fee of \$0.0125 per gallon of fuel oil shall be assessed at the time of importation into this state."

The rate will automatically be applied in the New Hampshire Automated Fuel Toll System for licensees that are certified to file electronically. Also, a paper version of the adopted form with the reflected rate change that allows for the remittance of the Fuel Oil Discharge fee of \$.0125 per gallon will be made available in the future at the following website: http://www.nh.gov/safety/divisions/administration/roadtoll/forms.html. [Go to the section entitled "Oil Discharge and Pollution Control (ODPC)", and select "RT 51 / ODPC Cover Sheet and Schedules"; the new form, when available, will read as follows in the bottom left corner, "RT51 (Revised 07/2013)".] This form shall be used with the reporting period starting July 2013 forward.
