**TO:** MOTOR FUEL DISTRIBUTORS, OIL DISCHARGE AND POLLUTION CONTROL  
LICENSEES, AND MOTOR FUEL AND PETROLEUM PRODUCTS TRANSPORTERS

**SUBJECT:** CLARIFICATION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF SAFETY ROAD TOLL  
BUREAU'S LICENSING OF MOTOR FUEL AND PETROLEUM PRODUCTS  
TRANSPORTERS PER RSA 260:42.

It is the intent of the Department and the Road Toll Bureau to only require transporters who transport motor fuel and petroleum products in bulk to register and license under RSA 260:42. For the purposes of defining bulk, the Road Toll Bureau uses administrative rule Saf-C 309.02 paragraph (s) "... For the purposes of this section, "bulk fuel storage" means a container greater than 55 gallons."

There is no intent to require the tracking of boxed and/or prepackaged petroleum products in containers of 55 gallons or less. Thus, transporters who only transport prepackaged and boxed petroleum products (i.e. quarts of motor oil) are not required to be a licensed New Hampshire Motor Fuel and Petroleum Products Transporter.
