NON-RESIDENTS TEMPORARILY RESIDING IN N.H.

Pursuant to, 1997 N.H. Law 234, these are the requirements to apply for a New Hampshire driver's license. All documentation must be written or translated into the English Language and submitted to:

1. Home country or out-of-state driver license status.

Please provide one of the following

- a. Copy of driving record/history from home country.
- b. Documentation from home country showing driver's license is not under suspension.
- c. Documentation that a driver's license was not held in the home country.
- d. Proof that you have held a U.S. out-of-state driver's license for longer than two years.

2. Temporary residence purpose.

Please provide one of the following:

- a. Copy of your 1-20 form.
- b. Letter from your employer stating the term of your employment.
- c. Letter from the learning institution or employer stating that the applicant is a spouse.

3. Temporary residence status:

- a. Copy of your VISA and 1-94 card.
- b. Social Security Number identification card if you are employed.

4. Temporary residence location:

- a. Copy of vehicle registration or current gas/electric utility bill.

Please do not call the office for approval. You will be notified in writing explaining how to apply for your New Hampshire driver's license.
