The Department of Safety, Office of the State Fire Marshal and the New Hampshire Fire Prevention Society believe that Fire Prevention and Life Safety should be a part of daily life throughout the year in every New Hampshire household. 3rd grade students are challenged to design a poster representing an important fire prevention & life safety message. This annual poster contest is open to **ALL** third grade students in the state of New Hampshire.

Students will need to:

- **Research** chosen topic from list to ensure message and picture are accurate.
- Use **white** paper not exceeding 11x17.
- Hold paper in **landscape** orientation.
- Fill out the contact information (found online) and attach to the **back** of the poster.
- Submit no later than **February 23, 2018**.

Posters may be dropped off to the Office of the State Fire Marshal or to one of the designated drop-off fire departments in the state. This list can be found on the website with the student information form for the posters.
