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**MEMORANDUM OF ACKNOWLEDGEMENT
BETWEEN THE STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE AND THE LOCAL TOWN/CITY
REGARDING STATE USE OF HOMELAND SECURITY GRANT FUNDING
ON BEHALF OF THE LOCAL TOWN/CITY**

The purpose of this Agreement is to set forth terms by which the State of New Hampshire shall expend Homeland Security Grant Funding on behalf of local towns and cities. The United States Department of Homeland Security issued grant numbers 2010-SS-TO-0069, EMW-2011-SS-00079 and EMW-2012-SS-00084 to New Hampshire.

Under this grant, the State of New Hampshire must allocate a minimum of 80% of grant funding to local towns and cities. Under provisions of the Federal law enabling the award of these funds to the State of NH, a written MOU acknowledges that the local entity (or entities) signed below understand that the NH Department of Safety as the SAA is authorized to make purchases on behalf of local agencies at their (local) request and acceptance. The undersigned acknowledges that the State of NH Department of Safety has held a portion of the Local allocation (80% funds) from the FFY grant years 201-, 2011 and 2012 to facilitate a more robust Training program in accordance with DHS grant objectives on behalf of the local entities.

Under this grant, the State of New Hampshire will provide and support, utilizing appropriate equipment purchased for this purpose, DHS-approved training to local town and city first responders. This training is coordinated by the Department of Safety, Division of Fire Standards and Training and Emergency Medical Services and will be provided by state employees who have been trained to provide this training or by representatives of DHS approved training partners.
