

Licenses To Be Deactivated 5/1/2015

All NH EMS Providers that have a license in hand that shows an expiration date of 3/31/15 are able to work as an EMS Provider in New Hampshire until 4/30/15 as long as all re-certification paperwork has been filed with the National Registry.

In order to continue to legally provide care, your license application must be fully processed and entered into the licensing database by the Bureau of EMS, by close of business on 4/30/15. Additionally, without a valid license, a provider can no longer access TEMSIS to complete patient care reports.

Licenses not in our database by 4/30/15 will be deactivated until completed applications are received and fully processed. Currently it is taking approximately 4 days to fully process a license.

Remember that continued certification and licensure is an individual responsibility. All providers and units should be aware of this deadline, and that per RSA 153-A:11, I, a license is required to provide emergency medical care in New Hampshire.
