### **INTRODUCTION:**

This policy outlines the dress code that is expected anyone attending a New Hampshire EMS Practical Examination.

### **POLICY:**

The practical examination is a hands on testing process for a medical profession therefore dress at these exams is expected to be professional. This applies to anyone involved with the process including candidates, evaluators, assistants, patients, Site Coordinators and Instructors.

Examples of inappropriate dress include, but are not limited to:

- Excessively tight clothing
- Shorts
- Short or low cut clothing
- Shirts/pants that don't meet
- High heels
- Department wear

If anyone attends the examination with clothing deemed inappropriate by the Examination Coordinator and can not correct the issue they will be asked to leave the examination.
