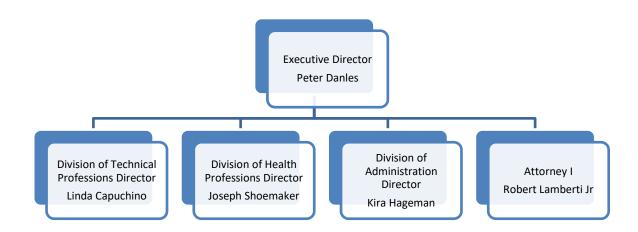

#### Office of Professional Licensure and Certification

#### **Mission Statement**

The principal mission of the New Hampshire Office of Professional Licensure and Certification is to safeguard the public health, safety, welfare, environment and the public trust of the citizens of the State of New Hampshire.



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#### **Executive Summary**

The Office of Professional Licensure and Certification (OPLC) provides administrative support to over 50 professional licensing boards, commissions and councils. The Boards, Commissions and Councils qualify and license, certify or register individuals and businesses and regulate their professions in order to safeguard the public.

#### Accomplishments

The protection and safety of consumers are primary tenets of the Office of Professional Licensure and Certification (OPLC). Our recent work has reflected those values, using a back-to-basics approach focused on ensuring adherence to rules requirements while targeting predatory practices.

All boards administratively supported by OPLC have been converted to the OPLC website.

The Board of Nursing sought legislation for the Enhanced Nurse Licensure Compact (eNLC). This allows Nurses licensed in eNLC states the ability to provide care to patients in other eNLC states without having to obtain additional licenses.

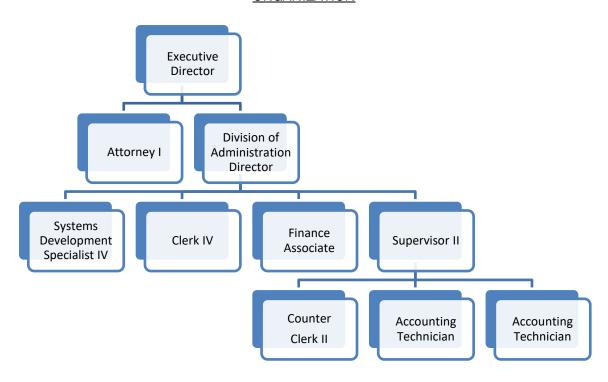
The Board of Pharmacy enacted legislation to ensure quality assurance that provides Pharmacists with the knowledge to improve pharmacy processes and enhance existing procedures in order to reduce the number of medication errors. Additionally, legislation was enacted for collaborative practice agreements, which create a formal practice relationship between a pharmacist and another healthcare provider that allow for the expanded services the pharmacist can provide to patients and the healthcare team. Moreover, the Board enacted legislation that created Advanced Pharmacy Technician roles. This allows the Pharmacist more time to spend with patients for counselling and PDMP lookup among other responsibilities. Furthermore, legislation was enacted that increased the number of vaccinations Pharmacists can provide.

We continue to address a foundational principle, customer service. We began reducing license processing times by offering online licensing for the Board of Nursing; Allied Health Professionals; and the Technical Professions. This has eliminated backlogs and made staff more accessible to customers.

The agency continues to participate in statewide efforts to decrease the abuse and misuse of prescription drugs. Recent data shows a decrease in "doctor shopping," and prescribers are checking the Prescription Drug Monitoring Program more liberally before advising the use of controlled substances to patients.

The Prescription Drug Monitoring Program (PDMP) is:

- A web-based data system that contains information on controlled prescription medications (Schedules II-IV) dispensed by NH licensed retail pharmacies and other dispensers.
- Intended to support legitimate medical use of controlled substances while limiting drug abuse and diversion.
- Intended to aid prescribers avoid drug interactions; identify possible substance abuse disorders and drug seeking behaviors.

**DATA LIMITATIONS**: Opioid addiction treatment programs that dispense methadone and buprenorphine are not uploaded into the NH PDMP system.

#### **Looking Ahead**

The Office of Professional Licensure and Certification (OPLC) is seeking legislation that will provide the agency with the ability to standardize the process of how administrative support and funding is provided to the various boards we support. We anticipate passage of this bill would provide for:

- Standardize the process of licensing
- Standardize the process of investigations
- Allow OPLC to assess licensing fees on a biennial basis and establish fees on behalf of each board, commission and council

The OPLC intends to convert many boards, commissions and councils we support to the My Licensing Office platform. This major improvement will:

- Provide online initial and renewal licensing for all professions supported by the OPLC
- Allow users to manage secure online licensing accounts
- Allow users to submit information electronically that has previously been hand delivered or via the US postal system
- Allow for secure submission of online licensing/certification fees
- Capture Drug Enforcement Agency (DEA) numbers for boards that write prescriptions to ensure licensees are registered with the PDMP

Key personnel will be initiating LEAN process improvement for the Licensed Alcohol and Drug Counseling Board. It is anticipated once this is complete, it can be implemented across all Boards, Commissions and Councils.
