

## Proposal Evaluation – 49 Proposals

49 grant proposals have been submitted seeking total funding of \$7.4 million. Staff led two teams of industry professionals and LCHIP board members in evaluating the proposals. Site visits to all project sites were conducted and two full-day meetings in October will lead to funding recommendations provided to the LCHIP Board of Directors, who will meet in early November to make the final funding decisions.
