State Fiscal Year 2021 Impacts

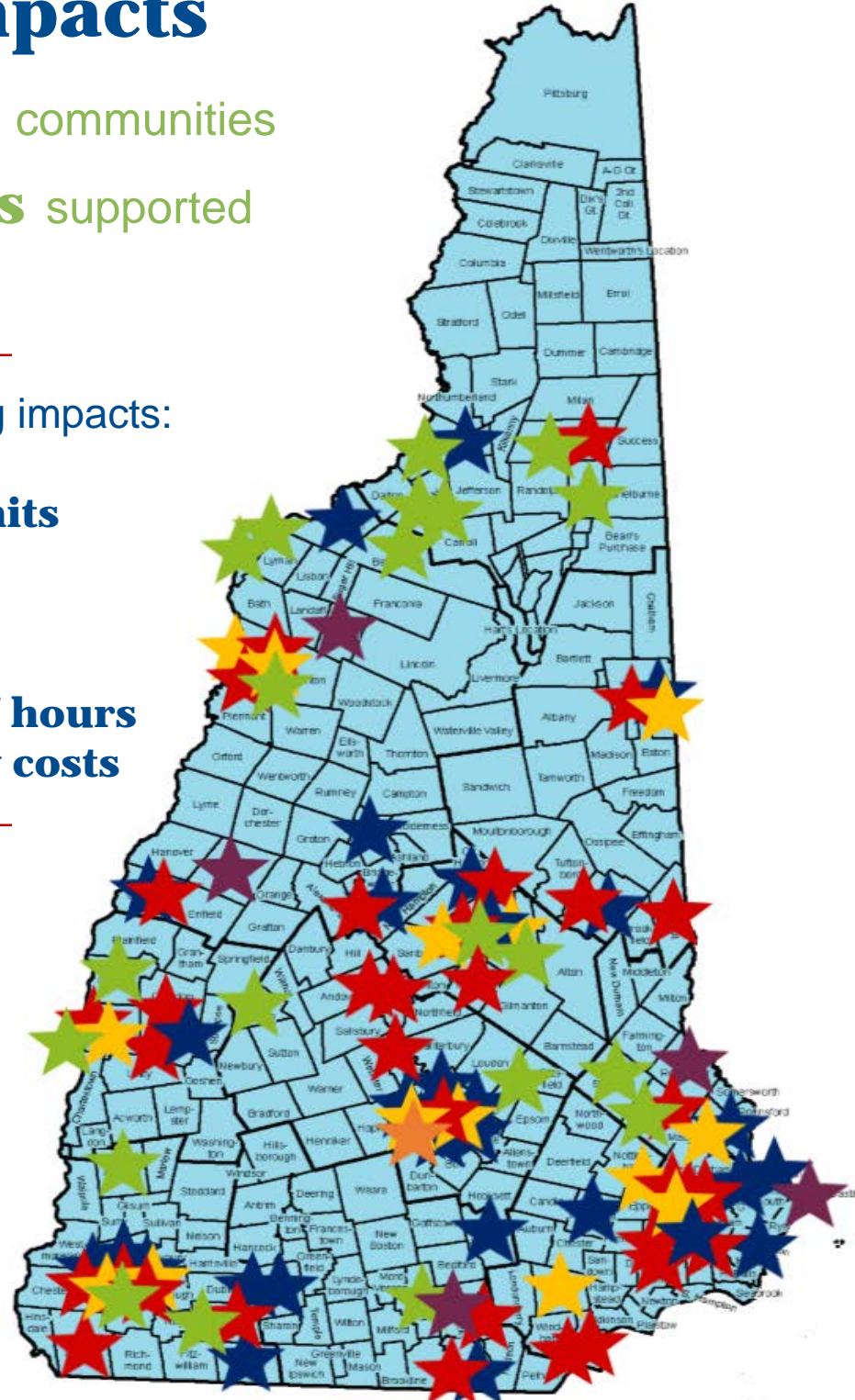
\$20 million infused into New Hampshire communities

145 community-based initiatives supported

191 business donors engaged

Initiatives supported by CDFA reported the following impacts:

- Assisted **8,707 people**
- Rehabbed, preserved or created **152 housing units**
- Created or retained **1,076 jobs**
- Supported **440 micro businesses**
- Developed or rehabbed **18,630 square feet**
- Estimated annual energy savings of **330,272 kW hours**
- Saved an estimated **\$69,500 in annual energy costs**
