## State Fiscal Year 2022 Impacts

**87 community-based initiatives** supported

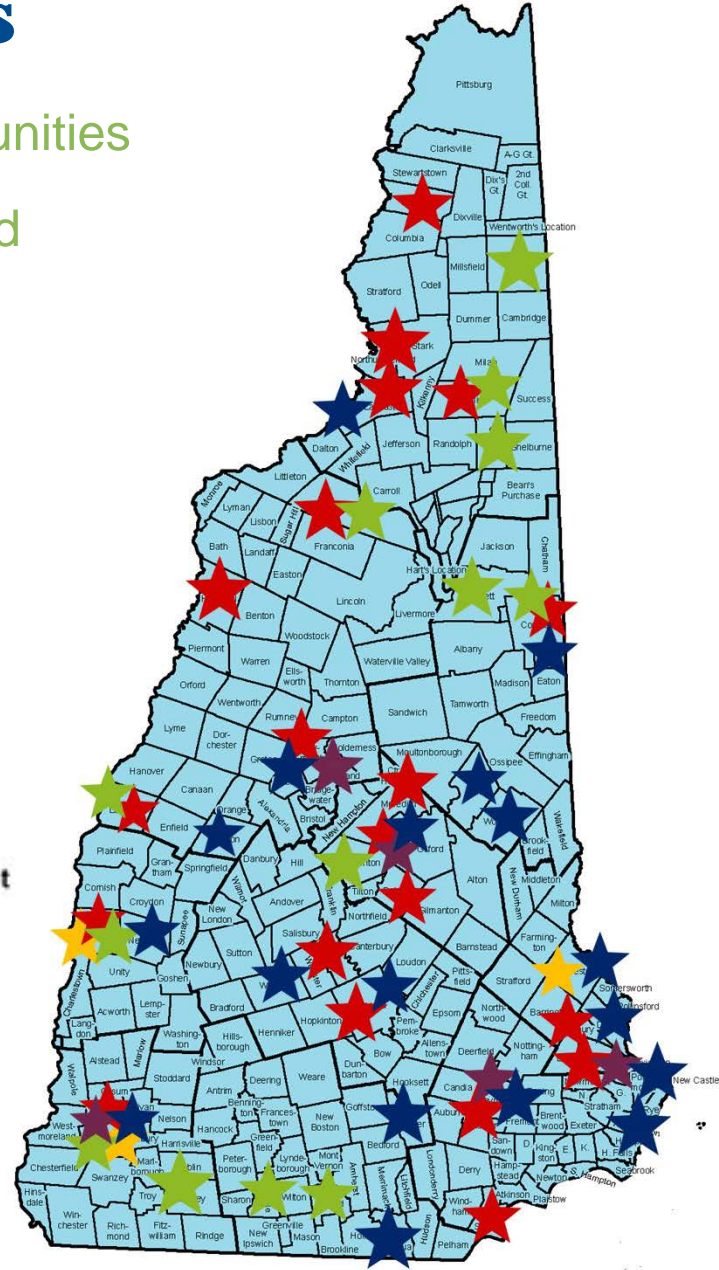
**189 business donors** engaged

### *Delivering Critical Services to Communities*

CDFA has worked alongside nonprofit partners to help address the most pressing issues facing New Hampshire – homelessness and housing instability. One example is funding for Hundred Nights, Inc. in Keene.

The organization provides shelter and crisis related services to those at risk of or experiencing homelessness in the Monadnock region. CDFA Tax Credits and Community Development Block Grant resources are supporting the development of a new, 48-bed emergency shelter and resource center.
