

# Enrollment of 4-Year College-Going NH Recent High School Grads





National Student Loan Data System, official 3-year default rates released 09/2020 on borrowers entering repayment in 2017. New England and Northeast averages exclude NH/USNH.





#### Revenue Sources FY20 Total = \$1 Billion+



#### Capital Funding Sources 2015-2020 Total = \$555 Million




#### Administrative Expense per Student
