BOARD OF MANAGERS MEETING MINUTES DECEMBER 18, 2023

*CALL TO ORDER BY CHAIRMAN:

The December 18, 2023, Board of Managers Meeting was called to order at 9:00 a.m. by Paul Lloyd, Chairman of the Board of Managers. Attendees presents were led in prayer by Robert Blais, Chaplain for the Board of Managers, and the Pledge of Allegiance by Chairman Paul Lloyd.

*APPROVAL OF MINUTES – November 20, 2023:

The Minutes of the Board of Managers Meeting from November 20, 2023 were reviewed and discussed. Motion was made by Raymond Goulet, Jr., seconded by Robert Blais, to accept the minutes. Minutes were accepted by the Board. There were no changes. Motion carried unanimously. The minutes will be placed on file.

***COMMUNICATIONS:**

NHVH New Addition – Commandant MacKay shared the committee is meeting one to two times a week on this project. We are currently looking at a 20-bed unit. We are on task with meeting the VA required schedule and anticipate going out to bid with the 30% design in February 2024. We are hopeful for a contract in March 2024; the chosen vendor will finish the 70% design and break ground in the fall of 2024.

Commandant MacKay reported that we have 1 resident with Covid and 3 staff that tested positive this week. We continue to enact best practices to keep veterans and staff healthy.

*CENSUS UPDATE:

Census/Admissions - As of December 18, 2023, we have 125 veterans in the Home.

Our current wait list is as follows:

- 38 Application Pool in Process
- 23 Wait List
- 3 Pending Admission from Wait List

*BUDGET UPDATE:

Commandant MacKay reviewed the FY23 Financial Summaries of the New Hampshire Veterans Home as of November 30, 2023 (Appendix C) with the Board.

*CAPITAL PROJECTS REPORT:

Commandant MacKay and Brian Baker provided an update on the New Hampshire Veterans Home's efforts to date concerning capital projects and operations highlights:

- **Fire Marshall** came through on Tuesday, December 12, 2023, with only a few minor findings. All were addressed before they left the building.
- **Paving Project** Will be going out to bid in the next two weeks with the project anticipated to start in the spring of 2024.
- **Eversource Lighting Project** The G&C submittal approval date is in January. Eversource anticipates a completion date of April 2024.
- Lift Project We are awaiting the scales to arrive and will then begin the project of installing 17 new lifts in residents' rooms.
- **Tarr North Drainage** The project has been sent to the Department of Public Works; an RFQ has been submitted for this project.

*RESIDENT / STAFF MATTERS:

Elaine Baker expressed a concern about inconsistent heat between areas of the Home; he dining room is getting cold again. Brain Baker will investigate this and have the heat adjusted.

The Tarr South neighborhood moved to Tarr East on December 6th. Residents are now in their new rooms and settling in well. Allan Bailey complimented the staff on the expeditious moving of residents' belongings that took place while residents were at breakfast.

***BOARD MEMBERSHIP:**

No anticipated changes to report currently.

***OTHER BUSINESS:**

Commandant MacKay informed the Board regarding the safety measures that are in place at the NH Veterans Home. An assessment of what we do well, and potential areas of improvement has been completed with some changes to be put in place, including training staff in an active shooter situation, as well as educating residents on the meaning of emergency codes and procedures to follow for these situations.
