Dear Residents and Families –

As the novel coronavirus (COVID-19) media coverage continues to remain widespread, I am connecting with you to provide a direct update on the New Hampshire Veterans Home.

First, the reports of **outbreaks** at congregate living facilities are very concerning. Our hearts go out to the facilities' residents, families, and employees affected by this virus. We continue to be very thankful that our residents and employees have not experienced any positive COVID-19 test results. Rest assured that we do not take this for granted, especially given the volatility of this disease. All precautions continue to be taken to keep our Home healthy.

Another topic discussed in the media is that of businesses starting to **reopen** in phases, beginning with those able to practice social distancing. Although the state is starting to reopen, please note that due to the continued risks of possible transmission to our veterans, we do not foresee an end to our Home's visiting restrictions any time soon. We understand and appreciate that it is not easy to stay distanced from loved ones, especially for a period of months. On the bright side, our practices have kept our veterans healthy. We have been able to avoid possible COVID-19 exposure because of the precautions we have taken while practicing our conservative approach. While we do not have any cases of the virus to report and 'knock on wood' this does not change, we sincerely appreciate your understanding of our need to make these difficult decisions in the best interest of our residents and employees' health.

Finally yet importantly, other popular media topics involve **Personal Protective Equipment** (PPE) and **face masks**.
