WorkInvestNH EMT Incentive Program



EMT Incentive Program is available to ALL EMS Units licensed with the State of New Hampshire/Department of Safety.

- Created in November 2022 using Federal ARPA funds.
- Provides TRAINING REIMBURSEMENT for new EMTs as well as Advanced EMTs.
- Provides **WAGE REIMBURSEMENT** to employers for new EMTs while in training.
- Provides RETENTION INCENTIVE PAYENTS for new EMTs after completing six months with a NH licensed EMS unit.

TRAINING REIMBURSEMENT

- Provides NH licensed EMS units with payment for 100% of training, certification and licensure costs for new EMTs and Advanced EMTs
- Payment provided by NHES to NH licensed EMS Unit upon certification as to completion of training and proof of payment.
- Newly licensed EMT or Advanced EMT must be certified as being AFFILIATED with the requesting NH licensed EMS Unit.

WAGE REIMBURSEMENT

- Provides NH licensed EMS units with reimbursement of 50% of wages paid to an employee while enrolled in EMT training.
- This only applies to new EMTs and not to Advanced EMTs.
- Wage reimbursement is capped at 4 weeks or \$2,000, whichever comes first, per employee.
- Person enrolled in EMT training needs to be employed and being paid wages during training in order to access this payment.

RETENTION INCENTIVE PAYMENT

- Provides NH licensed EMS units with \$1,000
 payment to be passed on to newly licensed
 EMTs after the newly licensed EMT completes 6
 months as a NH licensed EMT.
- The newly licensed EMT needs to be in a position requiring EMT licensure for six months.
- The six months can be spent being affiliated with one or multiple NH licensed EMS Units.

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WorkInvestNH - EMT Training Incentive Program

In order to help the New Hampshire EMS System **RECRUIT** and **RETAIN** additional Emergency Medical Technicians (EMT), the State of New Hampshire has created a new program that will pay for EMT and Advanced EMT related training; will offset a portion of wages paid to new employees; and will pay employees an incentive to remain in a position requiring an EMT Licensure. This program is available for anyone that started training on or after November 22, 2022. Please see detailed

Licensed EMS Units are able to utilize these incentives by participating in the WorkInvestNH-EMT program.

TRAINING REIMBURSEMENT

information below.

- The program provides employers with payment for 100% of the training, certification, and licensure costs for new and existing employees certified and licensed as EMTs and Advanced EMTs.
- WHO: EMS units who are licensed with the NH DOS and individuals who are currently employed or find new
 employment with a NH Licensed EMS Unit.
- WHAT: Reimbursement for 100% of the training, certification, and licensure costs for new and existing W-2 employees certified and licensed as new EMTs and new Advanced EMTs.
- WHEN: Once training is completed, on or after November 22, 2022, the Employer can be reimbursed by filling out the
 application and submitting proof of payment. The Employer can also wait until the license is fully obtained and submit
 reimbursement for licensing and testing fees as well.

WAGE REIMBURSEMENT

- The program also provides employers hiring individuals enrolled in EMT training with reimbursement of 50% of wages
 paid during the training period, not to exceed 4 weeks or \$2,000, whichever comes first.
- WHO: EMS units who are licensed with the NH DOS and have current W-2 employees attending EMT training.
 Trainings/Instructor Coordinators must be licensed with the NH DOS. AEMT trainings are not eligible for the OJT.
- WHAT: 50% of wages paid while the employee is in training. Up to 4 weeks or \$2,000. Paystubs must be submitted with an invoice and evaluation to be reimbursed.
- WHEN: Once the specified training period on the OJT Negotiated Contract is completed, and a paystub is provided, the
 wage reimbursement can be paid.
