

The suggested wording for permission for use of Emergency Equipment is as a follows:

To Whom it may concern:

The Fire Chief of \_\_\_\_\_ New Hampshire as authorized by the Director of Motor Vehicles here by grants permission to the individual listed below for his / her vehicle to be equipped with emergency "Audible and Visual" equipment. This emergency equipment may only be operated to the emergency event and during an emergency event if the situation so warrants. The use of this emergency equipment for use on the return from the event as outlines by statute.

**Note:** the Fire Chief may limit the use of this "Emergency Equipment" to the area / town in which he / she has jurisdiction. The law however does not limit the use of "Emergency Equipment" by statute. When a person is "exercising" this privilege the "Reasonable Standard" should apply.
